 is as follows.
- On June 17, 2019 introduction of medicinal herbs was given to the students of 7th and 8th standard with their benefits. The student volunteers were chosen for CAG synergy trained regarding the medicinal benefits of herb. They are as follows

- On August 19, 2019 sapling / cuttings of Tinospora cordifolia (Guduchi / Giloya) from the
 SGT university were taken to the school and plantation was done along the school students
 . After plantation the students were trained about Guduchi the medicinal herb along
 with its morphology, part used and its formulations.
- On August 26, 2019 the sapling of Aloevera from the SGT university were carried to the school and plantation was done along the school students. After plantation the students were trained about Aloe vera – the medicinal herb along with its morphology, part used and its indications.
- On September 2, 2019 the sapling of Ocimum sanctum (Tulsi) from the SGT university
 were carried to the school and plantation was done along with the school students. After
 plantation the students were trained about tulsi the medicinal herb along with its
 morphology, part used and its preparation.



- On September 9, 2019 we took the sapling of Catharanthus roseus (vinca rosea) from the SGT university were carried to the school and plantation was done with the school students.
